




1. The agreement will be valid for the period of 5 (Five) years from the date of this agreement.

Whereas, **National Cancer Institute**, Nagpur have expressed their consent and interest to permit for the clinical training, including University practical exam and Internship of Basic B.Sc. / Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing and M.Sc Nursing students of Maharshi Karve Stree Shikshan Samstha's Sitabai Nargundkar college of Nursing for Women, Nagpur at **National Cancer Institute**, Nagpur throughout their academic session.

3. Whereas, all curricula and content will be as prescribed by MUHS Nashik / Indian Nursing Council. NCI Nagpur and MKSSS' SN College of Nursing agree to jointly develop Oncology Nursing Human resource by formulating and executing a curriculum for M.Sc Nursing with specialization in Oncology and also a Post Graduate Fellowship in Onco Nursing, which will be duly approved by MUHS / Indian Nursing Council.

4. All curricula and their content will be as prescribed by Indian Nursing Council / MUHS Nashik. The curriculum and content of autonomous courses will be decided by faculty from NCI Nagpur as well as MKSSS' SN College of Nursing.

10. All information gained at the hospital which may include patient details, privacy, hospital protocol and / or hospital regulations will be used only for academic purposes by the students.




